# MESSAGE OF THE MONTH FROM THE EXECUTIVE BOARD

Throughout history, the traditional Jewish joke has consistently emerged as a prominent aspect of our collective Jewish identity. It goes something like: “We were attacked. Heroes arose to save us. We won. Let’s eat.” Immediately, holidays like Pesach, Purim and Chanukah come to mind with this theme. Many of our holidays also though force us to look at ourselves introspectively both as individuals and as special communities - local, national, and international. Are we living up to our own expectations? Are we setting the bar too high or too low for success? Are we fully recognizing our successes or identifying areas that maybe need a little more work?

Currently, you may or may not realize that we are in the midst of the Omer period, counting the days from Pesach to Shavuot, seven complete weeks. The mystical side of Judaism identifies various traits/characteristics that are assigned to each week and how they intersect. If we follow the “plan” of focusing concretely on each of these characteristics, we are given additional fortitude in reaching our goals of becoming our best selves individually and communally.

Over the last several months, your CBI Board of Directors has been engaging in multiple robust discussions to better identify our paths to future successes as a community. On Thursday night, June 12, at our annual meeting, we hope you will be able to join us for a more in-depth look at what our CBI of the future may entail. (More information on the Annual Meeting will be forthcoming after our May Board Meeting.)

Several encouraging signs that may be pointing to us heading in the right direction include the majority of our Shabbat morning Onegs have had individual or multiple sponsors. Attendance and participation have regularly been growing at our Shabbat morning services and has been strongly consistent for our Thursday evening minyanim. Our recent Program activities have been well attended, as those who attended our recent Yom HaShoah commemoration (and other events) can attest. Our Social Action Team has arranged a special tour of the Lawrence Boys and Girls Clubs and is also collecting various toiletry articles for the benefit of the Lazarus House. Our Program events coming up in May and June continue to stress variety and meaningful substance for those that attend, like the special program the Rabbi is creating for our Tikkun Leil Shavuot discussion on Tribalism and its implications (Sunday night, June 1). 
# MESSAGE OF THE MONTH FROM THE EXECUTIVE BOARD


